The following information is for enrolled students and their parents. All Decatur City Schools and Decatur High School code of conduct policies will be followed.

Purpose and Content

This class is designed especially for the development of men's voices. It is designed to develop the capabilities of the student to sing alone and with others in a variety of circumstances, read notated music, listen to and describe music, evaluate music and music performances, have knowledge of proper concert etiquette as a performer and audience participant.

Knowledge of and mastery of rehearsal and performance skills must be demonstrated for placement in Concert choir.

Required Materials and Obligations for Participation in Men's Chorus

Incidentals:	\$10.00 (bus, robe transporting, chorus pictures, picture framing, food when traveling. etc.

Chorus fee is due by 9/8/08. (A payment plan must be arranged with choral director by this due date) Inability to pay all-at-once is not an excuse. No student will receive credit for performances and receive a passing grade without satisfying the chorus fee.

Grading

1st – 6th grading period grading period
100% Performance based grade

The Christmas and Spring Concert serve as the semester test grade. The grade will be calculated as follows:

- 20 pts. earned for on time arrival
 - 30 pts earned for correct etiquette
 - 50 points for correct concert attire;
- 6 performance grades will be given each grading period. The weekly grade can be developed from daily rehearsal grading or from a specific performance.
 - The weekly performance grade will be lowered 5 points for each instance of non-satisfactory completion of the following performance abilities:
Sits with Correct Rehearsal Posture, Listens to rehearsal directives at cut-offs; Implements rehearsal directions; Has music folder at seat for rehearsal; Maintains eye contact with director during rehearsal; Obtains and replaces music folder in the folder cabinet before and after each rehearsal.

Although the above conditions for grading are in force, unless a student satisfies the financial obligation, submits required Travel Permission Form, submits required Biographical Information (to be completed on the chorus website) the student's chorus grade will remain at zero. For a student to be allowed to travel Parents must attend a mandatory parent meeting.
