DHS Choral Scholarships

Awards

Three scholarships (one \$1,000, one \$800, and one \$750.00) are awarded each year to graduating seniors who have been involved in the chorus at DHS.

Criteria

Candidates for these scholarships provide information regarding scholastic achievements, extracurricular participation and college plans. This information will all be considered as well as input from the choral director regarding participation and dedication to the choral program.

Process

This application is made available to all students via the chorus website and newsletter. Students complete and return all information requested to the scholarship guidance counselor. The counselor will collect completed forms and mail to an independent judge to select the winners. Judges will send names of winners to the counselor for announcement at the spring concert.

Required Items

- Completed application form ([Download in PDF format](#))
- Four (4) narrative paragraphs
- Two (2) letters of recommendation (teachers, community, or church leaders) in a sealed envelope.
- Page 1 and 2 of the application go to the guidance counselor and Page 3 come to Dr. Davis to complete.

Chorus scholarship applications should be turned into Krista Givens (room 104) by Friday, February 24, 2012.

Important Date to Remember:

May 6, 2012.....Spring Concert (2nd semester exam)

Concert Attire is as follows:

Boys: black shoes (no tennis shoes), black socks, black pants, chorus shirt. No earrings or other piercings. Hair must be neatly secured out of face.

Girls: black shoes (no tennis shoes or open toed shoes), black hose (no bare feet or legs), black pants or skirt, chorus shirt. No earrings or other piercings. Hair must be neatly secured out of face.
